Maths

I am learning to recite numbers in order to 10.

I am beginning to know that numbers identify how many objects are in a set.

I am learning to represent numbers using fingers, marks on paper or pictures.

I will be exploring shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects.

I am learning to understand about different occupations.

I am being encouraged to remember and talk about significant events in their own experience. •

Being imaginative

Reading

I am being to join in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.

Writing

I can sometimes give meaning to marks I make as I draw and paint. I am learning to ascribe meanings to marks that I see in different places.

Communication & Language

I am learning to listen to others one to one or in small groups, when conversation interests me.

I am learning to listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

I am learning to show understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting correct picture.

I am learning to imitate movement in response to music.

I am learning to tap out simple repeated rhythms.

I will be exploring and learning how sounds can be changed.
