## Our Approach to Teaching Phonics



Delce Infant School and Nursery considers reading to be a very important, pleasurable and purposeful life skill. The school supports your child's development of phonics through a rich a varied approach based around the use of the "Letters and Sounds" scheme.



From the very first day in nursery or reception class children are encouraged to develop the auditory, visual and social skills which will develop their love of reading and make learning the key skill of phonics fun. The "Letters and Sounds" scheme is enhanced by

a range of resources including the "Jolly Phonics" scheme. All children are encouraged to apply their known and developing phonic skills to both reading and writing on a daily basis in a real context.



Reception aged children are given a full pack of resources on entry to the school to support their learning. Later in Year 1 and Year 2 the children continue with an individualised approach and are ability streamed.
