## Girls

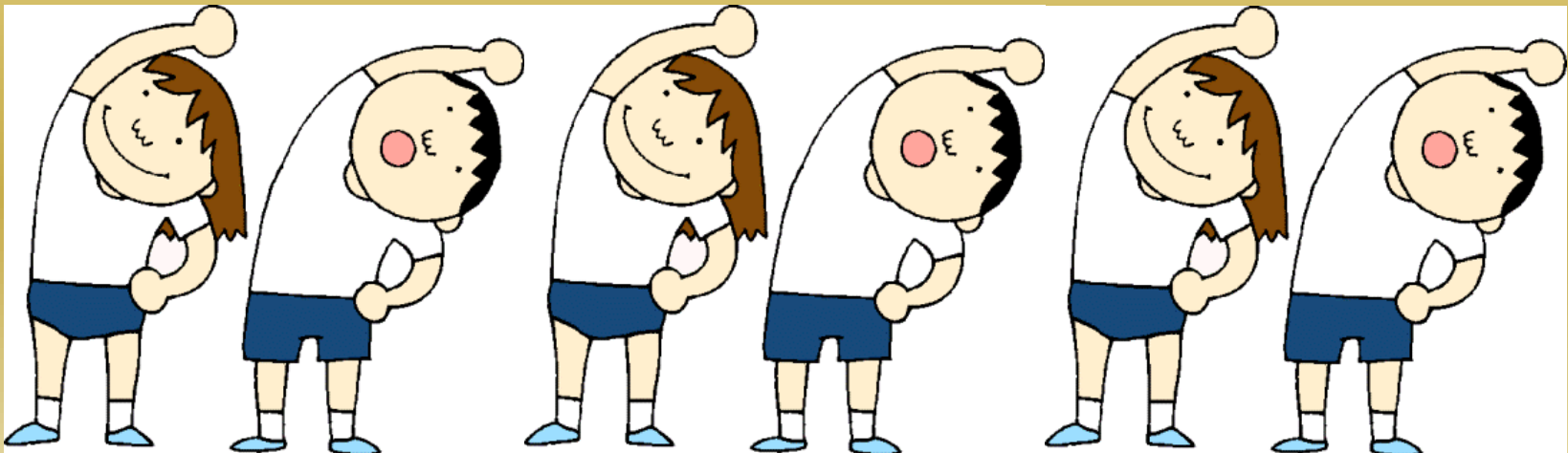
- White blouse

# SATs



At the end of Year 2 (during May), children take SATs (statutory assessment tests) in:

- Reading
- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG)
- Maths
  
- It will be your child's performance over the whole year which will determine whether or not they reach the nationally expected standard at the end of Year 2, rather than just being based on their test scores.
- The SATs tests will not in any way affect the school that your child will go to in Year 3.
