For adults and children: Help Darcy to help you...

<i>Please do:</i>	<i>Please do NOT:</i>
<i>Follow the adult's instructions about Darcy at all times.</i>	<i>Pull on any part of Darcy's body, her lead or harness.</i>
<i>Give Darcy lots of love and attention when she is being good.</i>	<i>Let Darcy rummage in bins or in people's bags</i>
<i>Be calm and gentle when touching Darcy</i>	<i>Allow Darcy to jump up on people or furniture, or to run inside school</i>
<i>Give Darcy clear instructions, one at a time</i>	<i>Give Darcy anything to eat or drink without Mrs Banks' permission.</i>
<i>Keep all human food and dangerous items away from Darcy</i>	<i>Let Darcy lick or chew you, or your belongings</i>
<i>Walk smartly with Darcy without pulling on her lead or letting her pull you.</i>	<i>Wake Darcy up if she is asleep.</i>
<i>Make sure she goes to the toilet in the designated Dog Zone.</i>	<i>Crowd around Darcy in a big group or make a sudden loud noise.</i>
<i>Say "No" in a clear, firm voice if Darcy does something she is not supposed to do, and tell Mrs Banks what happened.</i>	<i>Touch any of Darcy's toys or belongings unless you have been asked to by an adult.</i>
<i>Look out for signs that Darcy is OK and let the adult in charge know if she seems unwell or upset, growls, bares her teeth or whines.</i>	<i>Chase Darcy.</i>

Remember: Always wash your hands after playing with Darcy.
