Write a biography about Amelia Earhart or another famous pilot. What did they do? Why are they famous? Would you like to do something similar in the future?	Can you share all your numbers to 20? Can you write them, read them and put them in order? What is greater, 12 or 18? How do you know? Use the symbols < > = to compare numbers. Create a collage with groups of objects that make your teen numbers.	Go on a 1km, 3km or 5 km walk. Time yourself. Build on this by running or jogging.	Compare materials you see in the house. Make a list of metal things, wooden things and plastic things. Can you talk about why they are made out of different materials?	Cut out pictures of 2D shapes from newspapers/magazines, (e.g. a circular clock) to make colourful pictures. Next to the pictures write as many shape properties as you can think of.
Ask members of your family any key events they remember in their lifetime or from childhood.	Read and write numbers from 1-20 in numerals and words.	Walk to school at least 3 times a week. Keep a diary of the things you notice and see.	Describe the weather associated with the seasons and how the day length varies. Create a chart.	Create a journey themed painting or piece of art work
Create a traditional tale about a new character. What does your character look like? Where do they live? What happens in to them through the story?	Keep a diary of the times you do different things in a week. E.g. when you get up, visit a friend, eat breakfast, play, go to school, read, go to bed etc.	Climb the best tree you can find! Remember all our rules from Forest School and show your adult how we do this safely.	Design your own planet. What would you name it? Who/ what would live on it? What would be special about it?	Create some art in the style of Jackson Pollock. Can you think of different ways to print? How do you change the colours? What other art mediums could you use?
