

## Character Education

We will be learning about helpfulness, kindness and reflection thinking about helping each other to tidy, share and understand what each other enjoys.

We will show kindness to others in little acts and reflect on why we have different feelings and how we can try to share them respectfully.

## Maths

We will be consolidating addition and subtraction and developing different methods of recording.

We will look at recognising and describing different shapes.

We will explore intervals of time.

Also we will be solving one-step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

## Religious Education

### Christianity

We will be exploring the importance of love and forgiveness as part of Christianity.

We will be responding imaginatively to puzzling questions and communicating our ideas.

We will share thoughts about the birth of Jesus, advent and St Patrick.

## History/Geography

We will be finding out about how the Gunpowder Plot started and some of the problems the plotters encountered and research Guy Fawkes. We will be developing an awareness of the past and understanding how he lived compared with today.

Later we will look at geographical comparisons between London and a more rural area and naming the countries that make up the UK.

## Physical Education: Gymnastics.

We will demonstrate different body parts to travel on, use high and low methods of travelling in a sequence, to show different shapes with our bodies, to use control when balancing and jumping and to show different rolls.

## Computing

We shall be using technology within our classrooms e.g. Beebots, iPads and whiteboards.

Also we will be creating digital art using technology.

## Music

### Music Express

We will be learning to explore ways of using our voices expressively.

We will be developing skills of singing while performing actions and creating expressive stories.
